SUPPORTING FAMILIES IN CRISIS

ASKING FOR HELP IS A SIGN OF STRENGTH

SFC is a voluntary prevention program serving families in St. Lucie County. The program is for families that have at least one child between the age of birth to 17 years at home and do not have an open case with the Florida Department

SFC has a 100% SUCCESS RATE of keeping children out of the Child Welfare System.

Family Advocates are caring staff and trauma-trained professionals. They provide services to families and guidance as they work together through the crisis at hand. The program provides financial aid, if available, to avoid evictions or to reinstate utilities, help with domestic violence and substance abuse issues. In-home

counseling to help parents with stress management, jobs and budgeting skills is a key factor of the program. Community referrals are an integral part of this program to ensure families have their needs met.


