Marissa lived at the Hibiscus Village two years ago and was placed in a loving adoptive family. After leaving Hibiscus, she still received services through the Hibiscus Community Mental Health (CMH) Program. The CMH therapist worked with Marissa and her new family helping to process challenges they were experiencing. The therapist began the meeting with a Community Meeting, which is a tool used at Hibiscus as part of the Sanctuary Model.

To the therapist's surprise, the family still remembered the tools they received two years ago when Marissa left Hibiscus. Marissa used open communication, a calming Care Plan, emotional intelligence and managing emotions - all tools within the Sanctuary Model. The family expressed that Marissa taught them to check in every morning with a community meeting. Learning these tools to help process trauma and the challenges Marissa and her new family faced were instrumental in helping Marissa move forward in life.

SANCTUARY MODEL

The Sanctuary Model is a Trauma-Informed Care model and is an innovative, evidence-based model that addresses the health and well-being of abused, neglected, and/or abandoned children and caregivers, including staff and volunteers.

HIBISCUS RECEIVED SANCTUARY MODEL CERTIFICATION IN 2020

Trauma informed care has been associated with improvement in children's well-being and placement stability over time. The objective of The Sanctuary Model is to change organizational culture to emphasize respecting and appropriately responding to the effects of trauma at all levels. The Sanctuary Model is a trauma informed care practice and awareness that becomes almost second nature and pervasive in all services areas. It requires a system to make a paradigm shift from asking, "What is wrong with this person?" to "What has happened to this person?" The Sanctuary Model has helped our agency reduce trauma symptoms in our clients, higher productivity of staff through motivation, engagement and satisfaction of services, and has lowered staff turnover. Hibiscus Children's Center has implemented The Sanctuary Model throughout its entire organization and all staff are trained.


