

MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES OUTCOMES Fiscal Year 2022/23

- Over 550 children & families served annually.
- 80% of children who received treatment reduced trauma symptoms as evidenced by pre/post assessment scores.
- 83% of children increased protective factors as evidence by pre/post assessment scores.
- 100% of children in Shelter and Village received a mental health assessment within 24 hours of admission.



Non-traditional Therapy

Hibiscus Children's Center has partnered with **Justin' Time Stables** to provide the children living at the
Jensen Beach Shelter with **Equine Therapy.** This
innovative therapeutic approach will bring transformational healing for children and reach them in a way
traditional therapies cannot. This unique program is an
expansion of our current mental health program for
children and helps build self-esteem and life skills.

SANCTUARY MODEL

The Sanctuary Model is an innovative, evidence-based trauma-informed organizational change model. It addresses the health and well-being of children in our care and our staff and volunteers. All Hibiscus staff have been trained in the Sanctuary Model and the agency received recertification in 2023.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH SERVICES

Children & Families on the Treasure Coast and Okeechobee County

CHILDREN & YOUTH

Children and youth in the Hibiscus Shelter and Village receive professional mental health services on a regular basis to help them recover from the trauma of abuse. Community Mental Health services are provided to children in the community on the Treasure Coast and in Okeechobee County.

OUR STAFF

Our clinical staff consists of mental health professionals with a wide range of experience and expertise in child and family therapy. Our master-licensed therapists are trained in a variety of age appropriate and best practice treatment interventions including Play Techniques, Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TFCBT), Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT), Child-Parent Psychotherapy (CPP), and Eye Movement Desensitization Reprocessing (EMDR).

MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

Professional services are provided to children and youth in our residential programs and community mental health. Hibiscus specializes in the treatment of traumabased disorders, behavioral health, infant mental health, and healing victims of sexual abuse. The children also receive psychiatric services such as medication management in conjunction with our counseling services to ensure the best outcomes.

PARENTS AS TEACHERS

Provides parent education and support through in-home visits to Okeechobee families.

Four primary goals of the program:

- 1) Increase parent knowledge of early childhood development and improve parenting practices.
- 2) Provide early detection of developmental delays and health issues.
- 3) Prevent child abuse and neglect.
- 4) Increase children's school readiness and school success.

SEXUAL ABUSE TREATMENT PROGRAM

Specialized treatment services for children in our residential programs and in the community who are victims of sexual abuse, as well as for their families. We help families recover, working to prevent further sexual victimization while enabling families to develop healthy, non-abusive relationships. Clinicians who are certified in the Sexual Abuse Treatment Program receive specialized annual training and are certified through the Florida Department

Hibiscus Children's Center is the only Florida Department of Health sanctioned Sexual Abuse Treatment Program on the Treasure Coast and Okeechobee County.
