RESIDENTIAL PROGRAMS

TILTON FAMILY CHILDREN'S SHELTER

The Jensen Beach Shelter serves up to 36 children ages 12 & under, with siblings up to age 15. The Shelter provides medical and dental care, educational and literacy services, and mental health counseling.

HIBISCUS CHILDREN'S VILLAGE

The Vero Beach group home provides safe haven for up to 40 youth ages 12-17 years in a family-like environment. Teens receive mental health, medical, educational and career training services.

MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

Professional therapists provide services to children in the Shelter and Village to help them recover from the trauma of abuse. Outpatient services are provided to community children. Hibiscus has the only Dept. of Health sanctioned **Sexual Abuse Treatment Program** on the Treasure Coast & Okeechobee.

SUPPORTING FAMILIES IN CRISIS

A nationally recognized child abuse prevention program in St. Lucie County that helps alleviate a family crisis and keep children out of the Child Welfare System. Program has a 100% Success Rate.


SAFECARE PROGRAM
